Dear Parents/Guardians,

In celebration of our 59th National Day, our staff and students will take part in a heritage walk in the civic district on Thursday, 8 August 2024. The 3km walk will end with a picnic and community singing at the Marina Bay Sands (MBS) waterfront promenade.

On 8 August, students shall report in their PE attire at the designated MRT station by 8.00am. Please refer to Annex A for the reporting venue for each class.

Students will begin the walk on a pre-determined route as a class at 8.00am. They will be under the guidance of the Peer Support Leaders (from their own class) and close supervision of their Form Teachers. Along the way, students will be required to complete educational tasks at selected checkpoints. These activities will also serve to bond the class and encourage social interaction amongst the students.

Students are advised to bring the following items for the walk:

- 1. Filled water bottle (at least 500ml)
- 2. Snacks (optional)
- 3. Poncho / Umbrella / Cap / Sunblock
- 4. Asthma inhaler / medication (as necessary)
- 5. EZ Link card (to take public transport home)

Light refreshments will be provided at the end of the walk.

The event will end at about 10.30am and students will be dismissed from MBS. As no transport is provided, students will need to make their way home via public transport.

Students have been briefed on the event details and safety precautions. You may wish to reiterate the safety aspects and advise your child/ward accordingly.
