We are writing to inform that your child / ward will be a participant in a Geographical Investigations Fieldwork Project. This project will contribute to your child's Weighted Assessment in Term 2.

In the Geography syllabus, Geographical Investigation (GI) is a vital component in a meaningful geographical inquiry process where students are presented with opportunities to investigate geographical phenomena in authentic contexts.

GI provides students with opportunities to:

- carry out a more student-directed geographical inquiry, and participate in fieldwork, as students are required to go beyond the classroom to actively look for and gather data to address the inquiry
- apply and transfer what they have learnt from their geography lessons to a real world context
- be assessed more holistically in terms of a wider range of geographical skills
- develop the skills and attitudes to work individually and collaboratively in groups

Students undertake one GI a year. Your child's / ward's attendance is compulsory. Absence from this activity will be excused if students are unwell, covered with a Medical Certificate.
