


POLICE ADVISORY FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Dear Parents/Guardians,

In this edition of our Police advisory, we would like to advise you to adopt adequate anti-housebreaking measures to protect your homes from housebreakers.

- 2 Housebreakers can find ways into your homes through various methods:
 - a. Forcing open windows, grille gates or doors.
 - b. Cutting padlocks and grilles.
 - c. Gaining entry through the refuse chute, false ceiling, or ventilation openings.
 - d. Gaining entry through neighbouring house/shop.
 - e. Gaining entry by using household tools left outside the house.
- 3 You can adopt the following preventive measures to safeguard your homes:
 - a. Always secure your gate and windows with a shackled lock or a robust padlock. Change all locks promptly if any of your keys are lost or stolen.
 - b. Consider installing adequate Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras and security alarms.
 - c. Secure all doors and windows before going to bed.
 - d. For private housing estates, ensure that the access areas such as the frontporch are adequately lit during the hours of darkness.
- In addition, keep any valuable goods within your house under lock and key or in a secured environment to further deter any potential loss should a break-in occur.
- To stay updated with the latest crime advisories, do sign up and be part of our Community Watch Scheme (CWS). Let's prevent, deter and detect crime together.
