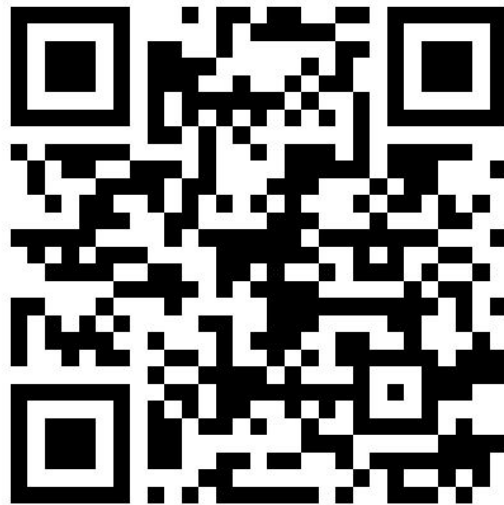
- Parents are strongly encouraged to discuss CCA choices with your child

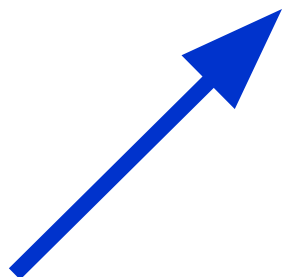
