Your child/ward has been randomly chosen to participate in an international study, the 2022 Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA).

PISA is an important educational research project investigating student literacy in mathematics, science and reading every three years. Singapore students performed very well in PISA 2018 among the 79 education systems that took part in the study.

Singapore's continued participation in PISA would keep us, as parents/guardians and citizens, informed about how our students are performing in comparison to their peers in other countries, and allow us to identify areas for improvement in the teaching and learning of mathematics, science and reading.

This year, more than 7000 students from all secondary schools and selected private schools in Singapore will be participating in the PISA 2022 Main Study. Your child/ward will complete a computer-based assessment as well as a questionnaire about his/her learning environment.

The PISA assessment for your child/ward will be administered on 20 April (Wednesday), 3pm – 5pm in school. Refreshments will be provided before the start of the assessment. You may rest assured that your child's/ward's participation will not affect his/her academic grade or progress in school, and that results will not be reported for individual students.

We appreciate your child's/ward's contribution towards this important study.
