Damai CCA Policy

- CCA is compulsory
- Most CCAs are conducted on either Mondays and/or Thursdays. (Extra training during peak seasons on Wednesday)
- Students who miss CCA miss out on an integral part of the school experience where strong friendships are forged and character is built

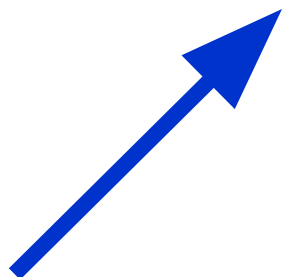
